QUESTION	ANSWER
<p>The requirements state that all responders must have a license to do business in San Francisco before a contract can be executed.</p> <p>Does this mean this RFP is limited to businesses that operate out [sic] of San Francisco?</p> <p>If no, is this still required even if we do not operate in San Francisco/ California?</p>	<p>The Court cannot issue a contract to any vendor that does not have a license to conduct business in San Francisco even if vendor operates outside of San Francisco.</p> <p>A vendor may choose to wait to apply for a license until an intent to award is posted but if there is a delay, the Court may move to the next best proposer who is ready to engage in a contract.</p> <p>This RFP is not limited to businesses within San Francisco.</p>
