



Mental Health Diversion Firearm Relinquishment Instructions (Penal Code §1001.36(m))

Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco

Overview:

You have been ordered to complete a Prohibited Person Relinquishment Form (PPRF) as proof of compliance with the Court's order that you may not own, control, purchase, possess or receive any firearms while you are in Mental Health Diversion.

You must report to the Adult Probation Department (APD) to complete a PPRF and turn in any firearms you have in order to participate in Mental Health Diversion. If you do not follow this order, you may be terminated from the program and returned to criminal court.

Next Steps Required:

- 1) Report to APD to complete the Prohibited Person Relinquishment Form (PPRF). APD is located at **945 Bryant Street, San Francisco, CA 94103** (Phone: 628-652-2100). The PPRF will require you to report any firearms you have, or to declare that you do not have any firearms. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR FIREARMS TO THIS APPOINTMENT.**
- 2) If you have one or more firearms, you must turn in these firearms to one of the locations listed on the back of this sheet **within 5 days** of this order if you are not currently in custody. If you are currently in custody, you must turn in these firearms **within 14 days** of this order.
 - a. You may turn in your firearms at a San Francisco law enforcement agency or a nearby county's law enforcement agency, or you may sell them to a federally licensed gun dealer (see locations on the back of this sheet). You may also designate someone to turn in your firearms for you. You must receive a receipt when you or your designee turn in the firearms.
- 3) Submit a copy of your receipt(s) to APD.

Important Safety Instructions

- Your **firearm(s)** must be unloaded.
- Place your **firearm(s)** in your locked trunk. If you do not have a trunk, lock your **firearm** in a container and place it in the back of your vehicle, out of reach.
- Do not put the gun in your glove compartment (CA Penal Code 12023.1(a)).
- Drive directly to the agency; do not drive to other locations.
- Park as instructed.
- Firearm(s) must remain locked and secured, as previously mentioned, until relinquished to law enforcement.
