SAN FRANCISCO SUPERIOR COURT SELECTS BRANDON E. RILEY AS ITS NEW COURT EXECUTIVE OFFICER

SAN FRANCISCO - Brandon E. Riley, a veteran administrator with more than two decades of management experience in California courts, has been selected as the San Francisco Superior Court's new Court Executive Officer.

Riley, who has served as the CEO of the San Joaquin County Superior Court for the past three years, is returning to his roots – he was the Chief Administrative Officer of the San Francisco Superior Court from 2006-2020.

"I am honored and delighted to have been selected by the San Francisco Superior Court bench to serve as the Court's next Court Executive Officer," Riley said. "I look forward to working closely with the court's leadership, staff, and the judges to improve the administration of justice throughout the City and County of San Francisco."

As CEO of the court in San Joaquin County, Riley managed five court facilities with 345 employees, negotiated labor contracts, implemented an online dispute resolution system for more than 15,000 traffic matters and managed a budget of more than \$60 million. In addition, he served on a number of statewide court advisory committees during his tenure.
